#### **Broadband Provision**

According to the latest OFCOM data (2013) Bretton post codes (where data is available) have a median average broadband range of 5.1-7.7 mega bytes per second. Accordingly it is to be expected that broadband provision in Bretton is poor and is constrained. This will have a negative effect on the ability of businesses in their day to day operation and on local residents seeking to access online services such as banking, post office services or online shopping.

#### Other Comments

Bretton has very few if any facilities but is directly adjoining Broughton Retail Park.

## Previous Surveys of Service Provision

Bretton is virtually non-existent however the adjoining retail park and the facilities in Broughton are very near by and available for use by residents of Bretton.
