## STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE ORDER

Following a request, a Speed Limit Assessment was undertaken on the length of A548 Sealand Road, Blacon, north west of its junction with Western Avenue, to the boundary of Flintshire with Chester West and Cheshire.

This assessment recommends the reduction of the existing 50mph speed limit to 40mph from a point 65 metres north west of its junction with Western Avenue Blacon, to the boundary of Flintshire with Chester West and Cheshire.

Safety concerns have been raised due to the existing Bus stop in this location and also the busy junction at Western Avenue.

The Authority continues its responsibility to consider the provision of the convenient and safe movement of motor vehicles and other traffic, and the proposed measures are aimed at ensuring that danger is minimised to road users as well as improving the amenities of the locality.

The proposals are detailed in the Public Notice and are contained in the proposed Draft Order.
