Notice of Proposal to Implement SCHOOL KEEP CLEAR Carriageway Markings at Ysgol
Maes Hyfryd and Flint High School, Flint

NOTICE is hereby given by the Flintshire County Council in exercise of its powers under The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect of which would be to introduce a 'School Keep Clear' restriction, of up to 43 metres in length on Maes Hyfryd, Flint, on the south-west of the carriageway at the entrance to Ysgol Maes Hyfryd and on Fifth Avenue on the south west of the carriageway at the entrance to Flint High School. Vehicles would be prohibited from stopping on the yellow zig-zag markings indicating the restriction between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

Reason for Proposal: Complaints have been received about obstructive parking particularly at school peak times in the area around the entrances to the Ysgol Maes Hyfryd and Flint High School. The Council therefore proposes to introduce a No stopping on School Keep Clear marking restriction. The purpose of providing School Keep Clear markings is to keep the space outside of schools free from parked vehicles so that children can be seen more easily when crossing the road.
